ExxonMobil, ConocoPhillips, Parex and state-run oil firm Ecopetrol are among companies to have submitted plans for unconventional exploration projects in the Middle Magdalena and Cesar-Ranchería basins.

The Colombian Petroleum Association (ACP) has said the initiatives could eventually produce 450,000boe/d and attract US\$5bn in annual investments, helping to replace the country's dwindling hydrocarbon resources.

Last week, energy minister Diego Mesa said the first pilot wells are expected to be drilled by the end of 2021.
