Ecopetrol, Labor Unions Reach New 4 Year Collective **Bargaining Agreement**

Colombian petroleum company Ecopetrol S.A. (BVC: ECOPETROL; NYSE: EC) announced on Monday that it reached an agreement with its largest labor union, the Unión Sindical Obrera (USO) for a new contract. The new collective bargaining agreement will be retroactively effective from January 1st, 2023, and will be valid for a four-year term. In addition, agreements were also reached with allied labor unions: Asintraho, Asonetrogas addition, agreements were also reached with allied labor unions: Asintrahc, Asopetrogas, Asteco, Sintramen, SUP and Utipec.

Ecopetrol and the unions agreed that for 2023, an annual wage increase of Colombian CPI + 1.5%, and, for 2024-2026, annual wage increases of Colombian CPI + 1.6%.

The agreements also include a commitment to continue promoting diversity, equity, and inclusion with a gender focus in the workplace, and to improve the well-being of workers, while also complying with criteria based on reasonableness, austerity and efficiency. The parties also agreed to allocate resources for social investment projects and energy transition forums.

Ecopetrol acknowledged the commitment and professionalism of the negotiating teams,
