- **Ecopetrol** is Colombia's largest company, controlling over 60% of the country's hydrocarbon production.

Ecopetrol S.A. (EC) is set to introduce new leadership in its senior management team starting May 1, 2025. The company, prominent in Colombia's hydrocarbon sector, has appointed Julián Fernando Lemos as the Corporate Vice President of Strategy and New Business.
