

Ecopetrol absorbs subsidiary holding 128-MW solar farm in Colombia

Colombian oil company [Ecopetrol](#) SA (NYSE:EC) said its shareholders had approved the merger by absorption of its subsidiary Parque Solar Porton del Sol, integrating a 128-MW solar farm into the group's portfolio.

[Ecopetrol](#) said the merger does not involve the sale of assets, closure of operations or any reduction in shareholder value. The integration is expected to deliver administrative, financial and tax efficiencies, while enabling more streamlined management of its renewable generation assets, the company added.

Under the deal, [Ecopetrol](#) will absorb Parque Solar Porton del Sol S.A.S., incorporating all its assets, operations, rights and obligations. The subsidiary's Porton del Sol solar farm, located in the Caldas department, is already in operation.

The entity was one of several special-purpose vehicles that [Ecopetrol](#) [acquired](#) from Norwegian utility Statkraft last year, gaining a portfolio of over 1 GW of solar and wind projects. Porton del Sol was the only [operational asset](#) in the package.

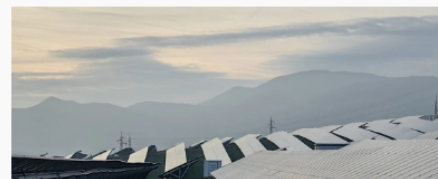
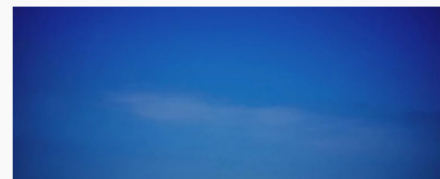
